

Welcome to the Trimley St Mary Parish Council news April 2025

School Support: We are really pleased to continue supporting our village school and we are donating 15 dictionaries, 15 Oxford Primary Dictionary, 30 First Atlas's, 15 Junior School Atlas's, 2 Physical Globes,2 Political Globes and 30 magnifying glasses. We are also funding the gardening tools.

School Reading Challenge at St Marys school: Alongside the above we are funding and sponsor the reading challenge. Starting after the Easter holidays 3 books a week and gifts are handed out in assembly.

Yellow Lines: After months of surveys, resident responses, discussions and debates, the Parish Council has now formally agreed to fund the provision of double yellow lines at junctions along Station Road and in part, High Road. This may take up to 12 months to get these lines put down – but they are on the way! The cost will be approx. £12k or a little more – but for the safety of both road and pavement users – be they motorists, cyclists, pedestrians or anybody else moving around our village, it's worth

the investment. Following the surveys last summer, we know we have the support of those who live in the relevant areas – and we would like to say a big 'thank you' for the engagement that has pushed this project forward.

Blocked Culverts: The PC followed the repeated procedure reports using the SCC reporting tool for blocked drains around the village. This pressure eventually come to the attention of the engineering department who escalated the need for action and following an site meeting a total of 14 Culverts were inspected and the following action agreed,

Stennetts Close. One immediately cleared of overgrowth. The severest has now been cleaned of the debris and pressured washed. All others have been pressure cleaned.

Station road junction with The Avenue have been cleared, pressure washed and repaired.

Faulkeners way, junction with the High road ,has been pressure washed.
