

The Ipswich to Felixstowe bus services are being revised from November 18th so that buses through the Trimley villages will be reduced from 4 to 3 per hour i.e. every 20 minutes. Sunday daytime services will remain half hourly.

Although all buses will run via Ipswich Hospital in future, they will no longer stop alongside the Garrett Anderson Centre inside the hospital grounds and will stop on Heath Road instead. This may cause some concern to parishioners as they will need to cross Heath Road (there is a signalled crossing) to pick up the bus for their return journeys so I felt that I should 'tip you off' in advance. The upside is that there will be a bus every 20 minutes to/from the Hospital and one every half hour on Sundays.

Also, at present 2 buses per hour currently run along Bishop's Hill and Felixstowe Road in Ipswich, part of Nacton Road, and past John Lewis/Waitrose – these places will no longer be served
