Christmas: The Parish Councillors and the Clerk wish you all a Merry Christmas. Thanks to Steve from Ginkgo for kindly donating their time to put up the new lighting on the Monkey Puzzle Tree at the Welcome Hall. Thanks also to the voluntary Councillors who installed the tree at the east green and decorated the village hall.

Remembrance 2025 3 wreaths were laid to remember the fallen, on the 9th & the 11th of November. On Armistice Day 30 children from St Marys Primary school attended and contributed with poems & wreath laying. A short Civic service was held at the peace sign in the grounds of Reeve Lodge.

Stennetts Playing Field: 29th October we were pleased to officially open the 60K Stennett's Park play equipment extension and upgrade with 27+ additional features. This has been matched funded from East Suffolk Council Local CIL Play Fund with thanks to who provided catering Roseberry Community cafe free hotdogs-cakes and drinks. The play area was revamped by the Parish Council in 2012

and a major upgrade in 2017 and now in 2025 we have doubled the amount of play equipment for the villages to enjoy. THE STENNETT MEMORIAL PLAYING FIELD is held in trust and the Parish Council are the corporate trustee for this land. Please remember this is a playing field and Dogs are not allowed.

2 more benches are in place and the Parish Council have agreed to fund a project to put a 3 to 3.5m wide seating area with a roof structure to provide shade and shelter. The structure will be made locally out of metal and therefore vandal proof.

With an integral roof and seating the new addition will supply shade for those who would like it and enhance peoples use of the fantastic new equipment.

Double Yellow Lines for the Station Road area update:

On October 16th the Parish Council submitted its final report to Highways in support of the proposed double yellow lining in the Station Road area.

This follows on from a protracted process that has been going since April 2024.

The powers that be will determine the strength of our proposal and hopefully, we will know before too long what the outcome is.

We will update you all as and when we know ourselves.
