GAYMERS LANE: The PC is aware of the repeated flooding issues on the Bridleway. We have consulted with residents and engaged with Suffolk County Council Public Rights of Way Officers to supply a solution to the drainage problem. A site meeting with us and officers from East Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council followed to view all issues related to the new building' site, surface water and hedging. We will continue to monitor all issues related to footpaths within the village, pursuing a satisfactory outcome for Gaymer's lane.

Stennett Memorial Playing Field: The Parish Council has accepted a recommendation from the Trust Management to install CCTV cameras in this area. It is essential that parents, have confidence in the safety of children using the play area especially following a major upgrade in exciting new play equipment. It will also assist in identifying the owners of dogs allowed to roam free and foul the field which is a constant problem. A reminder that dog faeces are toxic and can cause severe health issues to anyone touching them. That is why there is a bylaw For No Dogs Allowed on the playing field. It is hoped to deter Anti-Social Behaviour coupled to some vandalism around the Trimley Red Devils Sports Pavilion.
