Double Yellow Lines for the Station Road area update:

In April 2024, Trimley St Mary Parish Council, responding to residents' concerns took on the task of a survey to gauge the response to a proposal to restrict the parking of cars close to or even on various junctions on Station Road.

Due to serious concerns around pedestrian safety and the danger of potential vehicular accidents, the survey revealed overwhelming support to do 'something'. Initially the thought process was to use solid white lines. That changed when the Parish Council spoke to SCC Highways who suggested double yellow lines.

After many months of formal consultation, the SCC Highways team have formally approved the provision of the double yellow lines.

The Parish Council have spent several £1000's to make this a reality in support of the local community

The lines should appear in March / April 2026.
