

Litter Picker required by Trimley St Mary Parish Council

Would you like a part-time role in the village of Trimley St Mary helping to keep the area clean and tidy and looking better? Litter picking has environmental benefits by recycling and correctly disposing of rubbish; you prevent wildlife being harmed and stop micro plastics degrading into the soil and environment too.

If you care about your village and have a few hours a week to spare please read on.

Duties:

- To go around the village for up to 5 hours per week picking litter and disposing of the litter into appropriate waste receptacles.
- You will be able to work at times to fit in around your life.
- Every week you would be expected to email the time spent and the areas you have tidied to the Parish Clerk.
- On occasion the Parish Council reserves the right to ask you to tidy a specific targeted area within the Parish for litter picking where a problem has been reported or identified.
- Applicants should be over 18 years old and able to get around the village not be worried about being out in all weathers.

The Parish Council can provide gloves, a litter picker, tabard and bin bags. You will be expected to work in a safe way at all times.

There is a small honorarium payment to be discussed with the successful candidate(s). You would be expected to provide your bank account sort code and account details so that the clerk could pay you on-line following the first Parish Council meeting each month.

If successful you will be asked to attend the Parish Council meeting Monday 5th February to meet the Parish Council and the clerk and sign a contract and to provide your contact and bank details.
