

## **A14 junction 50 to 59: Ipswich Park & Ride signage**

I am writing to inform you that we'll be carrying out work to install new signage along the A14 between junctions 50 and 59 to improve the visibility of the Park and Ride sites.

We plan to complete this work over **four weeks** from **Monday 27 March to Thursday 27 April 2023**, on weeknights only, working between the hours of **8pm to 6am**, subject to weather conditions.

Due to the amount of work on this project, we have split the work into several phases. To deliver this work safely, we will require some closures. For more information about the location and dates of these closures please see table below:

### **Closures and diversions**

Most of our work will be carried out under lane closures, however, we will occasionally require some full closures. Details of the full closures can be found below:

- Junction 58 westbound exit slip – Monday 27 March – Traffic will be diverted up to junction 57 to exit and return on the A14 (Diagram 1).
- Junction 55 westbound exit slip – Monday 3 April – Traffic will be diverted up to junction 56 to exit and return on the A14 (Diagram 2).
- Junction 51 eastbound exit slip – Wednesday 5 April – Traffic will be diverted up to junction 52 to exit and return on the A14 (Diagram 3).
