

Welcome to the Trimley St Mary Parish Council news March 2024

High Road Safety The Parish Council continues to monitor the traffic flows via the detailed information downloaded from our 2 Speed Awareness Cameras. At peak periods, vehicle movements exceed 10,000 daily. From the information it is noted that they have an effect in reducing the speeds of the majority of vehicles passing these points. The ability of pedestrians to safely cross the road at pressure points is proving challenging.

The PC have met Suffolk County Council officials, supported by Councillor Bird and commissioned a feasibility study to provide a new pedestrian crossing in the vicinity of the Welcome Hall and the Church. This is also supported by District Councillor's Ninnmey and Reeve. It is believed this could be delivered by mid-2025 to provide a much needed safety crossing for our parishioners when using the facilities within this area.

The Council further negotiated with SCC to reinstate all the barely visible white lines in the village.

There are two Speed awareness Camera's at either end of the High Road.

We also note with concern that some parents are continuing to escort children across the High Road without using the Pelican Crossing. There was recently an incidence where a parent stepped out from behind a parked car; fortunately a serious incident was avoided by the prompt reaction of the motorists

As a Council we review the safety measures required by all road users and continue to lobby on the behalf of the parishioners to improve the infrastructure of the village.

Spring Flowers: as part of the parish plan we planted over 2000 spring bulbs and many of bee-friendly shrubs around the village, some of these bulbs are on the green on the eastern side and we would appreciate it if the public did not park there.
