
Trimley St Mary Parish Council

Stennetts Playing Field: We are very pleased to announce the 60K Stennetts Park play equipment extension and is now complete with 27+ additional features. This has been matched funded from East Suffolk Council Local CIL Play Fund and we thank them for their support. We thank our local Suffolk County Councillor Stuart Bird for £1748 towards 2 new benches at the playing field. Please remember dogs are not allowed on the playing field.

ST MARYS GREEN: We would like to thank our 2 East Suffolk Councillors Lee Reeves and Mike Ninnmey for £3000 funding towards the seating. We have put in 4 Octagonal accessible picnic tables and over 12 other forms of seating in the area. Following inspection of all existing seating within this area, the PC has authorised the installation of 5 concrete bases to these, as the ground around them has become extremely worn. This reflects the use they receive. It is very gratifying to the PC that all the new and existing seating is so well received. In the area bordering the new housing adjacent to Thurmans Lane area and after discussion with local families, we have ordered a 2nd Small football goal to match the existing single goal this will enable the children to have a double-sided game, whilst the Parents enjoy the benefit of the picnic table.

New Staff: We also welcome Carly Small as part time responsible financial officer; she will work closely with our part time clerk Nicky Dunn who we thank for working tirelessly for us.
