

This is a matter within Trimley St Mary, but given walkers from all parishes are likely to use the tracks, of interest to all.

Earth moving operations are due to take place on the Blofield bridleway, passing under the rail bridge. The organisers are looking to control public traffic (pedestrians, cycles, horse riders) and plant by traffic lights, therefore there is no closure. Hence the need for this email (as the PC would have received details of a closure).

I have been told that the plan is to commence on 26th October, and the estimate is for it to take about 1 month.

Traffic light control on a public right of way is something new to us. A professional traffic management company is operating the units and we have asked they ensure delays to the public are minimised. We have also said that we may ask for them to review the controls if problems arise.

The map below attempts to identify the area. BR 12 is the main route, and earth moving is happening from the south to the north of railway bridge. BR12 starts at Cordy's Lane and ends at Nicholas Road at the Pentelver roundabout.
